LOCAL LAW NO. # 2-2024

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 115 OF THE CODE
OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHAROKEN ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Asharoken as follows:

Section One. Legislative Intent.

The Board of Trustees finds that it serves the public health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Asharoken and that it is in the best interests of the Village of Asharoken to increase the penalty for a violation of §115-1 of the Code of the Village of Asharoken, entitled “Parking”.

Section Two.

Section 115-1 of the Code of the Village of Asharoken is hereby amended to read as follows:

No person shall park any automobile or other vehicle on any road or street in the Village or within six feet of either side of the pavement of any Village street, except that automobiles or other vehicles may be parked for a period not exceeding 20 minutes and only when the driver or occupant of said automobile or other vehicle has business with the occupant or owner of the premises before which said automobile or other vehicle is parked and provided that there is no place within the premises of said occupant or owner to park same. Such automobile or other vehicle, when parked, shall not obstruct the highways. Where special circumstances exist, permission to park may be granted by the Board of Trustees. Any person violating ~~the above provision of § 115-1 of the Village Code~~ the provisions of this section shall be liable for a penalty of not exceeding \$50 \$250.00 for each offense.

Section Three. Severability.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section Four. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
