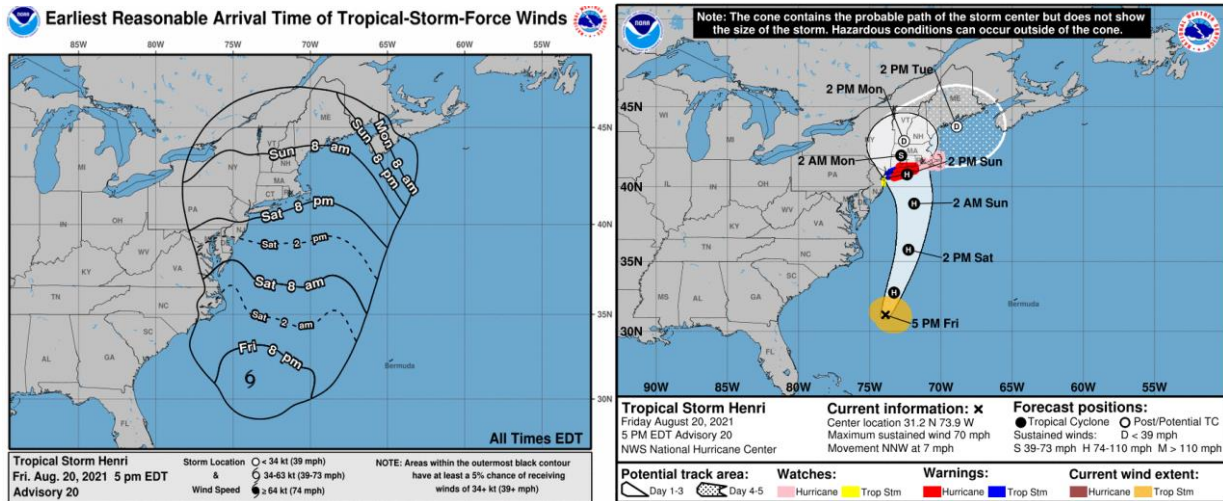

Tropical Storm Henri

Suffolk County OEM continues to monitor Tropical Storm Henri

****HURRICANE CONDITIONS EXPECTED ACROSS PORTIONS OF LONG ISLAND****



Hurricane Warning in effect Storm Surge Warning in effect

Tropical Storm Henri will likely track north nearing eastern Long Island as a Category 1 hurricane. Current track has Henri making landfall between Westhampton and East Hampton Sunday afternoon. The main threats from Henri are potentially life-threatening winds, storm surge, and heavy rain capable of producing flash flooding across Long Island.

Wind Impacts - Peak Wind Forecast: 50-65 mph with gusts to 80 mph - Window for Tropical Storm force winds: Saturday evening until early Monday morning. On east end plan for potential wind 74 to 110 mph life-threatening winds.

Peak Storm Surge Inundation: The potential for 2-4 feet above ground within surge prone areas. Potential for storm surge flooding greater than 3 feet above ground. Possible significant impacts across all coastal areas of Long Island Sound, and much of the Great South Bay and southeast coast of Long Island. Window of concern: early Sunday morning until Sunday evening

Rainfall amounts: 2-4 inches forecasted with 3-6 inches locally higher amounts.
