

Asharoken Sanitation 2024 Schedule

- Trash pick-up (Tuesday & Friday).
- Recyclables alternate every Wednesday; paper & cardboard combined, and plastic/glass and metal cans combined; see collection schedule.
- Yard waste picked-up the last Friday of every month; see collection schedule.
- Bulk items and scrap metal picked-up every Friday. A maximum of 4 items combined.
- Back door service: All items picked up from front or side door, cost is \$900.00 for 12-months. Contact Joe Carillo to sign up 516-449-3703.
- Contact Joanne at 631-807-1836 for ALL sanitation questions.

✓ Recyclables:

Acceptable: Mixed paper, cardboard, glass jars, glass bottles, plastic bottles metal food cans, metal beverage cans. Place in bin **not** in plastic bag.

Not Acceptable: Styrofoam containers soiled cardboard, plastic bags, ceramics, ceramics pots, waxed cartons, batteries, clothes hangers, plastic toys, and hoses.

WHEN IN DOUBT ABOUT RECYCLING -THROW IT OUT!

✓ Yard waste:

Acceptable: Bagged leaves, branches bundled and tied. Bundles must weigh less than 50 pounds, size of bundle branches 2 foot in length and 3 foot in width. Plant trimmings, tree limbs less than 5 inches in diameter cut to 2-foot lengths.

Not Acceptable: Grass clippings, mulch, wood chips, stumps, sod, lumber, dirt, rocks, root balls, land clearing debris, limbs that exceed 5 inches in diameter.

✓ Bulk waste:

Acceptable: Furniture, mattresses in a disposal bag, carpet, rugs, padding must be all cut in 4-foot lengths and rolled. Do it yourself construction debris bagged. Door panels cut in half. Railroad ties cut in 4-foot lengths; stockade fencing cut in 4-foot lengths. Large plastic toys.

Not Acceptable: Porcelain fixtures, (toilets, tiles, sinks). All stone counters, granite, bricks, mortar, concrete debris, dirt, and sand.

✓ Scrap metal items:

Acceptable: Washer, dryer, oven, refrigerator (remove doors), water heater and BBQ.

✓ E-waste items: Not accepted

All items should be dropped off at the E-waste site located at Scudder Beach, Woodbine Ave, to Beach Avenue to Scudder Beach in Northport Village. Computers, televisions, monitors, keyboards, scanners, printers, and all electronic devices.
